

ESPIRITU Schools "On Campus" Mitigation Strategies

The strategies are based on CDC guidelines https://www.cdc.gov/ and are aligned with current Federal, State and Local mandates. These strategies may change at any given time and, thus, this document may change.

Before Leaving Home

Parents, guardians and employees should follow the protocol below for symptoms screenings:

- Evaluate signs of illness. If a child or staff member has a temperature of 100.00 degrees or higher, he or she should not attend school or work.
- Parents, guardians and employees should routinely check MCDPH Guidance regarding what symptoms are related to Covid-19.
- If a child or staff member has tested positive for Covid-19, he or she should not attend school or work.

Face Masks

- Face masks are optional on Espiritu Schools campuses and transportations
- Face mask requirements are determined with local and/or state agencies.

Cleaning, Disinfection, & Air Quality

Frequent hand washing or sanitizing will be encouraged throughout the day. At a minimum, this will be encouraged at:

- Before and after breakfast and lunch
- Before and after using the restroom

Sanitizing and Disinfecting

 Disinfection occurs as regularly as possible by trained cleaning staff of frequently touched surfaces (tables, desks, furniture, light switches, doorknobs, etc.)

Indoor Air Quality

Air filters are changed on a regular schedule, and on as needed basis when warranted.











Protocols

Protocol #1 - A student or employee tests positive for Covid-19.

- Students and employees should stay home and not report to school or work. The parent(s) should contact the Front Office and the employee should contact your direct supervisor.
- If a student or employee tests positive, a 5-day quarantine is mandatory. This begins the day the test was taken. If a student or employee is eligible to return on day 6 (fever-free for 24 hours without using medication and /or symptoms are improving). The student or employee must wear a mask through day 10. If a student or employee is unable to wear a mask, then either should remain home for a full 10 days.
- Home tests kits are accepted. Home test kits should have both the students or employees name and date of when the test was taken written on the test kit.

Protocol #2 - A student or employee is sick with Covid-19 symptoms without a positive test.

Stay home until symptoms are resolving and are fever free for 24 hours.

Protocol #3 - A student or employee is exposed to Covid-19.

- It is recommended, if you are exposed to Covid-19, you wear a high quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5.
- Both parents/guardians/staff members will be notified if a student or staff member tests positive.
